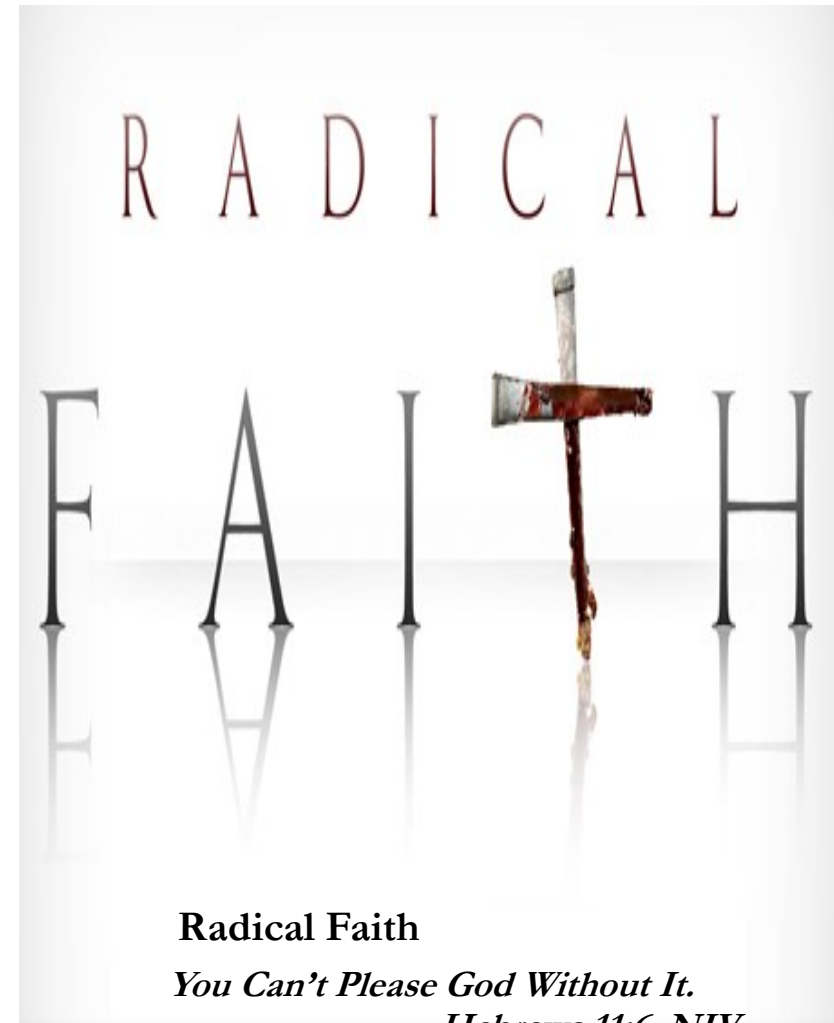

Matthew 10:1-15

¹ Jesus called his twelve disciples to him and gave them au-
thority to drive out impure spirits and to heal every disease
and sickness.

² These are the names of the twelve apostles: first, Simon
(who is called Peter) and his brother Andrew; James son of
Zebedee, and his brother John; ³ Philip and Bartholomew;
Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James son of Al-
phaeus, and Thaddaeus; ⁴ Simon the Zealot and Judas Is-
cariot, who betrayed him.

⁵ These twelve Jesus sent out with the following instruc-
tions: "Do not go among the Gentiles or enter any town of
the Samaritans.

⁶ Go rather to the lost sheep of Israel. ⁷ As you go, proclaim
this message: 'The kingdom of heaven has come near.'

⁸ Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have lep-
rosy, drive out demons. Freely you have received; freely give.

⁹ "Do not get any gold or silver or copper to take with you in
your belts— ¹⁰ no bag for the journey or extra shirt or san-
dals or a staff, for the worker is worth his keep.

¹¹ Whatever town or village you enter, search there for some
worthy person and stay at their house until you leave.

¹² As you enter the home, give it your greeting.

¹³ If the home is deserving, let your peace rest on it; if it is
not, let your peace return to you.

¹⁴ If anyone will not welcome you or listen to your words,
leave that home or town and shake the dust off your feet.

¹⁵ Truly I tell you, it will be more bearable for Sodom and
Gomorraah on the day of judgment than for that town.
